

## The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts and Kunsthall Charlottenborg present MFA Degree Show 2020



*Afgang* (MFA Degree Show) is the annual exhibition for the graduates from the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts' Schools of Visual Arts. The exhibition celebrates and presents works created by the new talents from The Art Academy and is the culmination of their education and an insight into the latest six years working process.

The exhibition is a fantastic opportunity to gain insight into how a number of different art practices are taking shape right here, right now. At the show, we can delve into these new significant contributions to the world of art, witnessing a number of takes on how the mindspace of art can offer us new perspectives on our present-day society,” says Helga Just Christoffersen, whom the graduates invited to curate *Afgang 2020*.

The exhibition is presented in the large skylight halls at Kunsthall Charlottenborg – a building which opened in 1883, fuelled by a vision of showing the very latest within the field of visual art. Internationally, this year has seen an entire generation of new artists having their degree shows cancelled, or having to face the challenge of adapting physical works to suit digital platforms, but the graduates from the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts have enjoyed unwavering institutional support and commitment to the importance of offering the general public the exhibition and works of art as originally planned.
